CONFERENCE RULES

This Conference is designed for youth (both teens and PENSAs) from all over Canada and USA who desire to experience a powerful encounter with the Lord through worship, teachings, prayer, discussions, workshops, and fellowship. The following rules will be enforced during the Conference:

1. No male should enter into a room designated as a female room and no female should enter into a room designated as a male room.
2. At the minimum, a business casual dress code will be enforced. All participants are expected to dress modestly and decently. Absolutely no shorts for males, no hanging pants below the waist, no mini-skirts, no cleavage-showing, back-showing dresses. Anyone dressed inappropriately will be asked to change; refusal and / or repeat violations will result in the person being asked to leave the Conference.
3. Nobody is allowed in non-designated conference areas of the Hotel, These places include the gym, the pool, attics, basements, vacant rooms not assigned for conference purposes, etc.
4. There should be no loitering and wandering in the halls and elsewhere during services. All participants are to be in their rooms after the evening service. At 12 a.m., lights out should be observed.
5. Conference badges must be worn at all times. There will be no admittance into the service auditorium and banquet hall without a badge.
6. Meal tickets are to be presented during meals in order to be served.
7. All cell phones, pagers, beepers, iphones and other electronic gadgets, must be turned off during the services. If a phone /pager has to be on for emergency or any such important purpose, please put it on vibration or silence.
8. Lateness will not be tolerated.
9. No one should change his or her assigned room. Please refrain from allowing anyone to sleep in your room if he or she is not assigned to it.

Do

- Be a part of all services and seminars
- Come prepared to take part in every facet of the service. Please bring a Bible, notebook, pen and offering to each session.
- Take notes during the ministration of the Word of God
- Fill in the seats from the front
- Kindly follow instructs from the ushers and youth leaders
- Take time to meet new people from other districts and countries
- Minimize noise and distractions as there will be other guests at the hotel
- Do sleep early so that you don't miss the morning devotions and also so that you are alert for the day's activities

Don't

- Stay in your room while services and seminars are going on
- Leave any empty seat in front of you; ushers will ask you to move up if they find any empty seat in front of you
- Lose your name tag; it will cost you \$20 to get a replacement
